- Flag order 44 orders placed by the public for 53 total flags, after taxes/expenses BC profit will be ~\$645. We also ordered 5 additional flags of each style to be used for give-aways, as well as 5 large flags to be hung in all of the ADM gyms, including the DAC.
- Gretchen is working on another apparel order, expect it to be open in early November for delivery before Christmas break.
- We are working with Kathy Grossman/Tin Roof Ink on ADM apparel products, however she will be working to sell her items wholesale through three local businesses (Adel HealthMart, Restoration Harmony and Azalea Lane) and will be sharing a portion of the profits with the BC.
